

# Breast Cancer Statistics

**25 women in Pennsylvania will be diagnosed with breast cancer today!**

**Breast cancer is the leading cause of cancer deaths in Pennsylvania in women between the ages of 25 and 54.**

**Nearly all breast cancers can be treated successfully if found early. When breast cancer is found at its earliest stage the five-year survival rate is 98%.**

**Approximately 9,000 women in Pennsylvania are diagnosed each year with breast cancer.**

**Approximately 2,000 women in Pennsylvania die each year of breast cancer.**

**There are approximately 103,000 women in Pennsylvania living with breast cancer.**

**Three of four cases of breast cancer arise in women with no known risk factors.**

**Breast cancer continues to be the most commonly diagnosed cancer in women in the U.S., regardless of race or ethnicity.**

**There are more than two million breast cancer survivors alive today in the United States.**

**One in seven women in the U.S. will be diagnosed with breast cancer during their lifetime.**
