



# Breast Cancer Awareness License Plate



**The total cost of each Pennsylvania Breast Cancer Coalition breast cancer awareness license plate is \$34.00.**

This fee includes the \$20 PennDOT fee, a \$10 contribution to the PBCC and \$4.00 to cover manufacturing costs of the plate. *(One registration card is included. Extra cards are \$1.50 each.)*

**PLEASE DO NOT** order your breast cancer awareness plate directly through PennDOT. The PBCC must process your application, then forward it on to PennDOT. PennDOT will not accept any applications that come directly from individuals.

**TO ORDER YOUR PLATE:** Fill out the information below AND the attached form, and return both with your payment to PA Breast Cancer Coalition, 344 N. Reading Rd., Ephrata, PA 17522. Payment can be made by check or credit card. Please make check payable to "PA Breast Cancer Coalition". If you are paying by credit card please note, we accept Visa, Mastercard and American Express. No refunds can be made after your plate order is placed with PennDOT.

**PLEASE NOTE:** If you lease your car, you will need to fill out an additional form that gives you ownership of the license plate. This form is available at [www.pabreastcancer.org/license.html](http://www.pabreastcancer.org/license.html) or by calling 800-377-8828 x104.

# PBCC License Plate Frequently Asked Questions

## **I see that PennDOT requires \$20 for the specialty license plate. So is the fee for the license plate \$34.00 or \$54.00?**

The breast cancer awareness license plate costs a total of \$34.00, which includes the \$20 that goes to PennDOT. The new plate will come with one new registration card. If you want additional cards, they cost \$1.50 each on top of the \$34.00.

## **Can I choose my own numbers or personalize the license plate?**

Unfortunately, no. These plates are issued in sequential order only. They cannot be personalized in any manner. These plates are not "pre-manufactured." As applications are received, they are manufactured in sequential order.

## **I have a handicapped license plate. Can I get this plate with the handicapped logo?**

PennDOT offers a person with disability plate that provides parking privileges and they offer a person with disability parking placard. (The placard hangs on the rear view mirror and provides the same parking privileges as the plate.) Unfortunately, they are unable to offer specialty plates with the handicapped insignia on it. A customer can apply for a PBCC plate and apply for a person with disability placard. This will afford you the same parking privileges as a person with disability plate, while still supporting the PBCC. If you want to apply for the placard, you can access the PennDOT form on the state website at [www.dmv.state.pa.us](http://www.dmv.state.pa.us). The form you need is MV-145A.

## **My registration is due soon (or I just renewed my registration). What should I do?**

Please do not let your registration lapse! Renew your registration as normal. Purchasing this plate does not automatically renew your registration. You will not be paying twice by paying for this specialty plate, as the \$34.00 is the fee for the specialty plate and does not affect your registration. On the next page of this application is a place to fill in your current license plate number and the expiration date of your registration. When your new plate arrives, it will have a new registration card and sticker with your expiration date. It does not matter where in the vehicle registration cycle you get this plate.

## **How long does the license plate application process take? (When will I finally get my plate?)**

The PBCC sends the applications to PennDOT in batches around the 15th and 30th of each month. Once PennDOT receives an application it takes about 6 weeks until the license plate arrives in your mailbox. Why? Because the plates are not pre-made. They are made in consecutive order as applications are submitted. Thank you for your patience!

**GENERAL INFORMATION REGARDING A SPECIALTY PLATE**

- This application, with Sections A and D completed in full, **must be returned to the organization official for submission to the Department.** No applications sent directly to the Department by the organization member will be processed. All applications must be sent to the Department by the organization.
- The applicant listed in Section A must be a registered owner of the vehicle as indicated on the vehicle's registration credential. If the vehicle is a leased vehicle, Form MV-1L, "Application for Lessee Information", must be completed and attached. (Note: Form MV-1L is available on our website at [www.dmv.state.pa.us](http://www.dmv.state.pa.us).)
- Fee required with this application is \$20.00. The participating organizations may charge additional fees to offset the cost of plate production and a contribution to the organization. Please contact the organization representative for correct payment method. **DO NOT SEND CASH.**
- No specialty plate will be duplicated. If your plate is lost, stolen or defaced you will need to reapply for a specialty plate by completing this application and submitting with the appropriate fees. Should you need an immediate replacement plate, please complete and submit Form MV-44, "Application for Duplicate Registration Card, Replacement of Registration Plate, Renewal Sticker or Weight Class Sticker" and submitting a fee of \$7.50. A standard issued plate will be issued until the replacement specialty plate can be provided. (Note: Form MV-44 is available on our website at [www.dmv.state.pa.us](http://www.dmv.state.pa.us).)
- Requests for specialty registration plates are restricted to passenger vehicles, trucks and motorhomes with a registered gross weight of not more than 9,000 lbs. **Motorcycles and trailers do not qualify for specialty registration plates.**
- NO REFUND OF FEE will be issued when applicant cancels request after order is placed.
- When the applicant ceases to be a member in the organization as listed in Section B, the registration plate must be returned to the Department. Complete Form MV-44 and submit a fee of \$7.50 for reissue of a regular series registration plate.
- Specialty plates are issued in number sequence only and may not be personalized.
- To avoid possible problems with citations with your old registration plate, return it to: Department of Transportation, Bureau of Motor Vehicles, Return Tag Unit, P.O. Box 68597, Harrisburg, PA 17106-8597 after you have received your special organization plate.
- Please allow 4-6 weeks for delivery.
- If applying for a Fraternal Order of Police plate, the PA State Lodge seal and the PA State Lodge Recording Secretary signature must be affixed to this application.
