The **PA Breast Cancer Coalition** is a statewide nonprofit headquartered in Lebanon that supports and represents individuals facing breast cancer in Pennsylvania. The PBCC serves survivors, families, researchers, caregivers and medical professionals through programs like:



Friends Like Me - Friends Like Me is a free care package program for women who are newly diagnosed with breast cancer. Each box is customized to correspond with a woman's diagnosis and treatment including resources, small gifts and safe cosmetics.

In 2024, the PBCC sent over 1,600 care packages across PA.

PBCC Research Grants Initiative – The focus of the PA Breast Cancer Coalition is "finding a cure for breast cancer now... so our daughters don't have to." The PBCC has contributed more than **\$6 million** in grants to Pennsylvania breast cancer researchers working toward that goal.





Legislative Advocacy - Take action. Save lives. The PBCC is dedicated to ensuring that *all* women have affordable access to early detection and treatment for breast cancer. The Coalition championed major pieces of legislation including:

- Act 1 of 2023 eliminates all costs associated with supplemental breast MRI, ultrasound, and BRCA-related genetic testing and counseling for individuals at high risk, insured under PA law
- Breast Cancer Early Screening Act
- Breast Cancer Reconstructive Surgery Coverage Act
- Breast Density Notification Act
- Breast Density Screening Coverage Act
- First state in the nation to offer 3D mammograms at no cost

Patient Advocacy - Through its personalized patient advocacy program, the PA Breast Cancer Coalition offers resources, guidance and support to individuals affected by breast cancer in Pennsylvania. Whether it is navigating an insurance maze or finding a free mammogram, the PBCC is here to help, ensuring no one fights alone.

PA Breast Cancer Coalition Conference – The PA Breast Cancer Coalition Conference is the premiere statewide conference focused on the latest in breast cancer treatment, research and survivorship. The Conference is held every October in Harrisburg for 1,000+ attendees including survivors, caregivers, healthcare heroes, researchers, lawmakers and advocates.
