

ACT 1 OF 2023 ASK YOUR INSURER

ABOUT ACT 1

Act 1 of 2023 removes <u>all costs</u> associated with breast MRI and ultrasound as well as BRCA-related genetic testing and counseling for individuals at high-risk who are insured under PA law. Act 1 <u>does not</u> change federally regulated insurance such as self-insured plans, Medicare or Medicaid.

QUESTIONS TO ASK YOUR INSURER

1. I'm at high risk for breast cancer and my doctor typically recommends breast MRI or ultrasound. Will these screenings be covered at no cost under Act 1 when it goes into effect?

2. Am I insured under Pennsylvania law or insured under federal law?

Act 1 of 2023 applies to individuals insured under Pennsylvania law only. Ask your insurer if that includes your plan. Federal law covers many types of insurance including Medicare, Medicaid and ERISA plans, among others.

3. When will my no-cost coverage of breast MRI, ultrasound, genetic testing and counseling begin?

All state-regulated insurance plans must be in place before the end of 2025, however, the law takes effect for many plans between 2024 and 2025. Please check with your insurer to see when it takes effect for you.
